NOTICE TO MARINERS No. 11/2026

River Hull Tidal Surge Barrier – discontinuance of amber (secondary) warning lights and fog signal

MARINERS ARE ADVISED that, following consultation by the Environment Agency with London Trinity House as General Lighthouse Authority, ABP Humber as the Local Lighthouse Authority, and the UK Hydrographic Office, **the following lights and fog signal are discontinued with immediate effect:**

Amber flashing lights on Sammy's Point, Victoria Pier and the upstream side of Drypool Bridge which gave additional warning of the flood barrier when deployed, and

Fog signal Horn(1) 2 seconds (occasional) on Sammy's Point which indicated when the barrier was deployed in reduced visibility.

MARINERS ARE FURTHER ADVISED that the **primary** warning signal, which is **red flashing “wig-wag” lights** mounted on the upstream and downstream faces of the flood barrier (four each side), **will continue to be used to warn when the barrier is deployed.**
